DIRECTIONS: To be used only in the manufacture of a rodenticide which is registered under the Pest Control Products Act. Users should remove clothing immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then wash skin thoroughly and put on clean clothing.

FIRST AID

If in eyes, flush with water for 15 minutes.

If on skin, wash with soap and water.

If swallowed, give patient one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with a finger or a blunt object; repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. For all cases of human ingestion, immediately notify a physician or poison control centre. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION

If swallowed by humans, or animals, this material may reduce the clotting ability of the blood and cause bleeding. Vitamin K₁, in the form of intramuscular or subcutaneous injections, or

by oral ingestion are suggested remedial treatments for anticoagulant poisoning. The severity of the case measured by establishing prolonged prothrombin times (P.T.) will determine appropriate therapy. Monitoring P.T. will indicate the necessity of repeated treatments.
