DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This labeling must be in the possession of the user at the time of application.

Use Restrictions: Use against Norway rats, roof rats, house mice and meadow voles, in and around homes, industrial, agricultural and commercial buildings, and similar manmade structures. Do not place this product in areas where there is a possibility of contaminating food or surfaces that come in direct contact with food.

Selection of Treatment Areas: After removing as much food as possible, determine dry, acid-free areas where rats, mice, and voles will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally, these areas are along walls, by gnawed openings, in or beside burrows, in corners and concealed places, between floors and walls, or in locations where rats, mice, and voles or their signs have been seen. Protect bait from rain or snow. Remove as much alternative food as possible.

Application Directions:

RATS: Apply 1 to 2 teaspoon amounts of this product per placement. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait until all signs of feeding have stopped.

MICE AND VOLES: Apply 1 teaspoon amount of bait at 8- to 12- foot intervals. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait until all signs of feeding have stopped.

RATS, MICE AND VOLES: Replace contaminated or spoiled bait immediately. Collect and dispose of all dead animals and leftover bait properly. To prevent reinfestation, limit sources of rodent food, water and harborage as much as possible. Do not treat the same area with this product at less than 30 day intervals.

IMPORTANT: Before using this product, read and carefully observe all applicable directions, precautionary statements, "IN AND AROUND STRUCTURES" directions with Important steps 1, 2 and 3, and other information appearing on the EPA registered product label for Prozap[®] Zinc Phosphide Rodent Pellets, EPA Reg.
